## Volunteers and refugees explore the city together

Three times three hours – a good time to get to know a new person and a new area. We therefore invite locals and interested newcomers to Cologne to join each other in three-hour walks of exploration, the “Welcome Walks”.

In times of Corona the walks can also take place online, i.e. via Facetime, Skype or Zoom.

During these meetings the teams can talk about their lives, they can exchange recipes or cook together, they can listen to or talk about music, sing, play online chess or other board games, visit online museums, practice German or do whatever they like.

Both groups profit from the Welcome Walks: the refugees get to know places that are of interest to them, the volunteers get to see Cologne from another perspective. And both get to know people, whom they wouldn't have met otherwise. And that leads to a mutual understanding
